- Zoom, podcast, testimonials
  - Doesn't need to be set up framed around GCS prep, have residents do it as part of their programs, low cost, and low burden.
  - Have topics and dates in hand at member meeting for sign ups. Talk about what R/F is and not to confuse it totally with GCS prep, are two different things.
  - PODCAST TOPICS
    - Why, What drew you to residency
    - Pathways beyond Residency/Fellowship: What do I get out of it?
    - Clinical Reasoning
    - Teaching Component
    - Patient Advocacy
    - Stress Management/Time Management
    - Using Evidence in Practice
    - How to be a Mentor in your Clinical Practice, or Leader in your Clinic
  - Avoid live at all costs! For quality and evidence control. Should be recorded video or just audio.
  - How to promote these podcasts? APTA Geriatrics, Programs can promote on their IG/FB and can be mutually beneficial to promote content and their programs.
